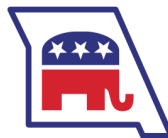

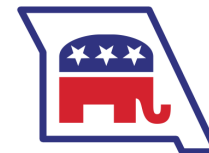

REPUBLICAN PRINCIPLES IN ACTION

What does it mean to you and for Missouri to elect strong conservative Republican leaders ?

Protecting Innocent Life



Under Republican leadership, legislation was passed to protect the lives of innocent Missouri children. Laws were passed that prohibited the transport of minors across state lines for abortions without parental consent, and to protect women by requiring abortion "clinics" to meet specific standards causing some abortion clinics to close. Governor Blunt halted payments to Planned Parenthood and at the same time increased funding for Show-Me Healthy Women helping more women get important health care without compromising their values by visiting abortionists. Additional legislation was passed encouraging more alternatives to abortion through counseling services for pregnant women, and keeping abortion providers like Planned Parenthood out of Missouri classrooms.

Educating Missouri's Children

Under Governor Blunt's leadership, funding for Missouri classrooms has increased by more than half a billion dollars with no job-killing tax increases on hard-working families, while scholarship funding has increased from \$25 million to \$72.5 million. When Gov. Blunt took office, he immediately ended the severe cuts on higher education put into place by Democrats. Recognizing that education begins at home, he also increased funding to the Parents As Teachers program, ensuring more families are served by this program for young Missouri children.



Quality Healthcare

Governor Blunt introduced his bipartisan MO HealthNet plan to replace the old, broken Medicaid system. Under MO HealthNet, for the first time in Missouri history every participant will have access to primary and preventive care through the choice of a Health Care Home. Insurance Missouri was designed by Gov. Blunt to expand health

coverage, lower health care costs and reduce the number of Missourians without insurance. The measure includes tax relief for Missouri families by allowing them to deduct the cost of their health insurance premiums.

Economic Growth & Job Opportunity

Under Democrats, Missouri was amongst the worst in the nation in job loss. Under Republican leadership, Missouri has seen record high employment numbers, the lowest unemployment rate in six years, and nearly 100,000 new jobs since Governor Blunt took office. Republicans believe in providing new incentives for employers that help create new, family-supporting jobs with good pay levels and health coverage. Governor Blunt also signed new workers' compensation bills to help workers injured on the job while fighting abuse of the system.



Responsible Government

When he took office, Governor Blunt inherited a \$1.1 billion budget deficit. This year, Missouri's budget has an estimated \$292 million surplus because he balanced the budget the Missouri way - by getting control of spending and holding the line on taxes.

Defending The Second Amendment

Republicans believe in the rights guaranteed under the Second Amendment to the Constitution. Republican lawmakers passed the 'Katrina Doctrine' bill that guarantees Missourians will retain their Second Amendment rights in times of emergency and the 'Castle Doctrine' to ensure the right of law-abiding citizens to protect their families and property from criminals.



Stopping Activist Judges

Governor Blunt called on statewide office holders and legislators to stand against taxation without representation and join him in support of House Joint Resolution 1, which prevents unelected judges from ordering tax increases on Missourians. Not surprisingly, the trial attorneys and their Democrat cronies have fought the proposal.
